ELIGIBILITY

The Foundation's purpose is to provide tuition assistance for financially deserving students to attend a Catholic grammar or high school within the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Newark, NJ.

- 1. Awards are for a single academic year and recipients are encouraged to re-apply each academic year.
- 2. **Applications** for the academic year beginning in September, **must be submitted** by the preceding **April 15.** Applications submitted after April 15 will NOT be reviewed.
- 3. Awards are paid directly to the student's school, usually in late August.
- 4. Applications will NOT be considered without the principal's signature, endorsing the application. It will be the responsibility of the parent or guardian to have the application signed.
- 5. **Documents** demonstrating financial need **must be included** with the application. At a minimum this should be the prior year's W2. If applicable, current SNAP, unemployment determination letter, or other supporting documents should be submitted with the application.
- 6. In addition, priority will be given to families with multiple students enrolled in a Catholic school and to single parent families. Scholarships are based on need without regard to gender, race, religion, or ethnic background. Students must be in good academic standing and have never been suspended or seriously reprimanded.
